

**TONNAGE GRANT APPLICATION RESOLUTION
2015**

WHEREAS, the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act, P.L. 1987, c.102, has established a recycling fund from which tonnage grant may be made to municipalities in order to encourage local source separation and recycling programs; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent and the spirit of the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act to continue and to expand existing programs; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection is promulgating recycling regulations to implement the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act; and

WHEREAS, the recycling regulations impose on municipalities certain requirements as a condition for applying for tonnage grant, including but not limited to, making and keeping accurate, verifiable records of materials collected and claimed by the Municipality; and

WHEREAS, a resolution authorizing this municipality to apply for such tonnage grants will memorialize the commitment of this municipality to recycling and to indicate the assent of the Township of Holmdel to the efforts undertaken by the municipality and the requirements contained in the Recycling Act and recycling regulations; and

WHEREAS, such a resolution should designate the individual authorized to ensure the application is properly completed and timely filed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Holmdel that Holmdel Township hereby endorses the submission of the recycling tonnage grant application to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and designates Victor Stevens to ensure that the application is properly filed; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the monies received from the recycling tonnage grant be deposited in a dedicated recycling trust to be used solely for the purposes of recycling.

RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE FORM, MATURITIES
AND OTHER DETAILS OF NOT TO EXCEED \$5,600,000
GENERAL OBLIGATION REFUNDING BONDS OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF HOLMDEL, NEW JERSEY AND
PROVIDING FOR THEIR SALE

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Holmdel, in the County of Monmouth, New Jersey (the "Township"), has heretofore issued the following series of bonds: General Obligation Bonds, Series 2008, issued in the original aggregate principal amount of \$8,804,000, dated December 4, 2008 (the "2008 Bonds"); and

WHEREAS, the 2008 Bonds currently are outstanding in the amount of \$6,259,000 and the 2008 Bonds maturing in each of the years 2019 to 2026, inclusive, and 2028, in the aggregate principal amount of \$4,921,000 (the "Refunded Bonds"), may be redeemed prior to maturity at the option of the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township desires to redeem the Refunded Bonds on or after December 1, 2018, at a redemption price of 100% of the principal amount of the Refunded Bonds and has adopted a bond ordinance entitled "Refunding Bond Ordinance Providing For The Refunding Of \$4,921,000 Aggregate Principal Amount Of Outstanding Bonds Of The Township Of Holmdel, In The County Of Monmouth, State Of New Jersey, Appropriating A Sum Not Exceeding \$5,600,000 To Pay The Cost Thereof And Authorizing The Issuance Of Not Exceeding \$5,600,000 Aggregate Principal Amount Of Refunding Bonds Of Said Township To Finance Such Appropriation," which authorized refunding bonds to be issued to refund the Refunded Bonds;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOLMDEL, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) that:

Section 1. There shall be issued bonds of the Township in an amount not to exceed \$5,600,000, being all of the bonds authorized by a refunding bond ordinance (Ord. No. 2015-06), adopted on April 28, 2015 and entitled:

"REFUNDING BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REFUNDING OF \$4,921,000 AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF OUTSTANDING BONDS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOLMDEL, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, APPROPRIATING A SUM NOT EXCEEDING \$5,600,000 TO PAY THE COST THEREOF AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF NOT EXCEEDING \$5,600,000 AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF REFUNDING BONDS OF SAID TOWNSHIP TO FINANCE SUCH APPROPRIATION."

Section 2. The bonds referred to in Section 1 hereof are sometimes hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Bonds." The Bonds will be issued in one series as "General Obligation Refunding Bonds, Series 2016". The Bonds of said issue (i) shall be dated the date of delivery of the Bonds, (ii) shall mature in each of the years 2016 and 2019 to 2028, inclusive, or such other years as may be determined by the Chief Financial Officer, (iii) shall bear interest at the interest rates per annum as determined by the Chief Financial Officer, (iv) shall be sold at such price or prices as determined by the Chief Financial Officer, and (v) may be subject to redemption prior to their stated maturities as determined by the Chief Financial Officer, as shall be set forth in the proposal for the purchase of the Bonds acceptance of which is authorized pursuant to Section 5 hereof. The Bonds shall be numbered one consecutively upward, and will be issued in fully registered form.

Section 3. The Bonds shall be payable as to interest at the corporate trust office of U.S. Bank, National Association, Morristown, New Jersey, payable on the May 15 and November 15 prior to each June 1 and December 1, commencing June 1, 2016, in an amount equal to the interest accruing to each such June 1 and December 1, and payable as to principal at the corporate trust office of U.S. Bank, National Association, payable on the fifteenth day of the month immediately preceding the due date therefor, or on such dates as determined by the Chief Financial Officer. Interest on the Bonds shall be calculated on the basis of a 360-day year or twelve 30-day calendar months.

The Bonds shall be subject to the parameters set forth as follows and otherwise consistent with the terms included in the application submitted by the Authority (as hereinafter defined) to the Local Finance Board in the Department of Community Affairs, State of New Jersey (the "Local Finance Board") on April 22, 2015 (the "Application"): (i) the aggregate principal amount of the Bonds does not exceed \$5,600,000, (ii) the maturity structure or weighted average maturity for the Bonds is substantially similar to the structure submitted to the Local Finance Board in the Application, and (iii) all conditions described in the Application as submitted to the Local Finance Board for the sale of the Bonds are satisfied.

Section 4. The Bonds shall be signed by the Mayor or Deputy Mayor and the Chief Financial Officer, by their manual or facsimile signatures, and the corporate seal of the Township shall be affixed thereto, or imprinted or reproduced thereon and shall be attested by the manual or facsimile signature of the Township Clerk or Deputy Township Clerk.

Section 5. The Bonds are hereby sold and awarded to The Monmouth County Improvement Authority (the "Authority") by an Authorized Officer at a price determined by the Authorized Officer pursuant to the terms of a Bond Purchase Agreement between the Township and the Authority (the "Bond Purchase Agreement"). The Mayor and Deputy Mayor are hereby authorized on behalf of the Township to execute the Bond Purchase Agreement by and between the Township and The Monmouth County Improvement Authority and the Continuing Disclosure Agreement by and between the Township and U.S. Bank, National Association, if required.

Section 6. The Bonds and the registration provisions endorsed thereon shall be in substantially the following form:

All salaries and wages herein shall be effective January 1, 2016.

Section 8.

There shall be 15 holidays per year for all Township Departments as established by Resolution of the Mayor and Township Committee.

Section 9.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed. (\$243.00)
