The Ramps and Rails Program assists low to moderate income homeowners who are in need of a wheelchair ramp to help them enter and exit their home safely and easily.

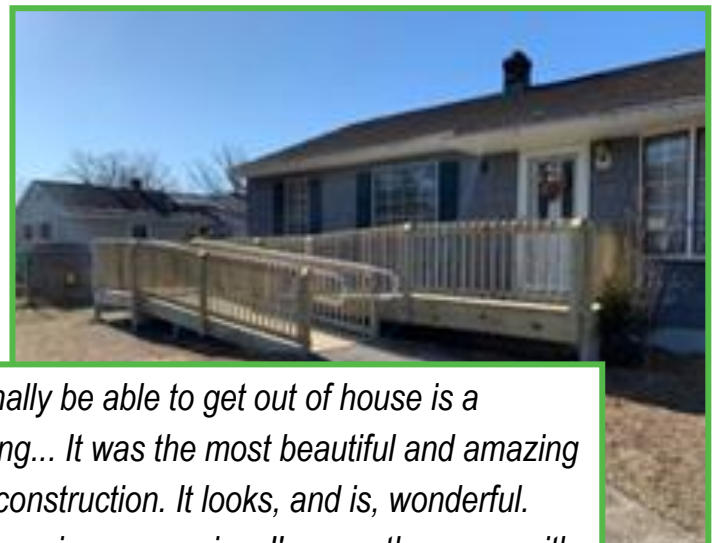
Program qualifications include:
